PACKING LIST

You should not need to make any special purchase to attend FCSEC. Items on this list should be readily available. We suggest that you tape a list of everything you pack to the inside of your suitcase. This will help you remember to take home everything you bring! Be sure to put your name on all items you bring.

REQUIRED ITEMS

Sheets for a single bed

Blanket & pillow

Towels & washcloths

Beach towel for pool

Toiletries (soap, shampoo, toothbrush, etc)

Enough casual clothes for your stay, including pj's, swimwear and tennis shoes or sneakers (**Tennis shoes, sneakers or other types of closed-toe shoes are required for all classes—due to safety reasons, please no sandals or flip-flops are to be worn to classes.**)

Dress outfit for banquet (boys--khaki pants and button shirt; girls—nice pants, skirt or dress)

Jacket or sweater

Notebook paper, pens & pencils

SUGGESTED ITEMS

These are suggestions to make your stay more comfortable, but are not required.

Light weight backpack or tote for carrying items between classes/activities.

Raincoat or umbrella

Desk lamp

Alarm clock or clock radio

Inexpensive digital camera or disposable camera

Tennis racket (if you want to play tennis during free time)

Swim goggles (if your eyes are sensitive to chlorine)

Coat hangers

A plain white or light colored T-shirt or pillow case and a sharpie for AUTOGRAPH DAY

Spending money, if desired, for purchases at the Bookstore, Post Office, and/or campus vending machines. (Please bring ONE and/or FIVE dollar bills only.)

For campers without cell phones, calling card or instructions on calling collect (Campers are asked to limit calls to no more than three calls for the week.)

DO NOT BRING THE FOLLOWING ITEMS

Skateboard

Roller blades

Bicycle

Fan (Rooms are air-conditioned.)

Computers, DVD players, or walkie-talkies

Hand-held games, expensive electronic equipment (iPods, iPads, cameras, digital recording devices, etc.)

Please note-----Cellular phones are permitted, however access and use will be limited and restricted. Upon arrival, campers will be asked to turn in cell phones to counselors. Campers will have access to cell phones after evening activities. After use, cell phones will be turned back to counselors. (Currently Verizon, US Cellular, Sprint, nTelos, and T-Mobile are the only cellular providers with service on our campus.) For campers who choose not to bring a cell phone to camp, campus telephones will be available for collect or calling card calls. Campers and parents must read and agree to abide by the FCSEC Cell Phone Policy.
